

Applications for phd studies in psychology with non-psychological and/or non-Bologna qualifications



- Please send your application to your potential supervisor at the Department of Psychology.
- The application should contain a well elaborated research proposal which thoroughly matches to the potential supervisor's research focus, as well as the usual application documents.



If your application is successful, your prospective doctoral committee (main and second supervisor) will invite you to a **30-minutes' interview**. In certain circumstances, the interview can take place by SKYPE.



If the interview is rated positively, the prospective doctoral committee will invite you for admission to the doctoral studies and you can start registration procedures to enrol at Zurich University. **In case of non-psychological and/or non-Bologna master degrees, phd students will have to fulfil achievements (between 15 and 45 ECTS) additionally to the required phd studies credit points.** These additional requirements usually consist of modules at bachelor or master level which are part of the curriculum of psychology studies at Zurich University.
